A: From the After Downloading of the software we further see that the software has a signature "C R E A M 1 O 2 0" which is the result of a MD5 checksum. To crack the software we further see that the creator of the software used the serial number "BNH45WIP" to sign the software. As you can see in the above gif: If the serial number is "BNH 45W IP" then there is only 6 possible combinations of 7 letters. Have you tried the possible combination of letters with number and you got the correct serial number? 2001 ICC Trophy The 2001 ICC Trophy was a cricket tournament held in Scotland in May 2001. It was a tri-nation series between the three fully Qualified Associates (Canada, the Netherlands, and the United States) of the ICC, along with Ireland. Each team played the others twice in the round-robin stage. The final was contested between Canada and the United States, and the United States won by ten wickets, marking their first ICC Trophy title.
